

Dear residents,

Dorchester Living invite you to attend our community consultation drop-in sessions regarding proposals for our Village Centre North planning application. This scheme comprises three mixed use commercial and residential blocks, one of which will include a convenience store. The blocks will also include a number of one and two bedroom apartments, of which 30% of these will be affordable.

The Village Centre North has been designed in conjunction with the previously approved application for buildings 455, 457 and the Canopy Link to create a comprehensive village centre for Heyford Park. These new additions will bring much needed retail and amenities to the centre.

As well as information boards and plans detailing the proposed scheme, there will be representatives from Dorchester Living who will be available to answer any questions that you may have. There will be an opportunity to provide feedback on the scheme to date, and we will review the scheme in light of any feedback received before it is submitted to Cherwell District Council. We will also be asking residents the type of retail and other amenities they would like to see included in the centre in due course.
