**Bring your entries to the marquee on the The Green between 9am to 11am on Saturday 2nd September.**


**You can enter as many categories as you wish however only one entry per category.**

- 4 Gladioli (max 3 blooms or one spike)
- 5 Herbaceous perennial (max 5 blooms)
- 6 Home grown outdoor potted plant
- 7 Home grown indoor potted plant
- 8 Floral display of late summer flowers - large (larger than 12" / 30cm)
- 9 Floral display of late summer flowers - small (less than 8" / 20cm)
- 10 Floral display "From the Hedgerow" - UNDER 14s ONLY
